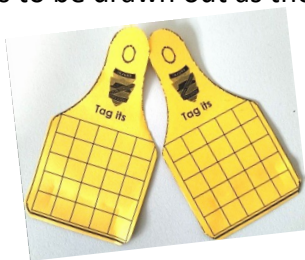
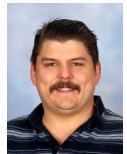
Roma and District Track & Field nomination forms have been sent home. If your child is away on camp with no sibling at school, please check your emails. Forms must be returned by first day of school next term.
